

CADD Technician

Summary/Objective

The Drafting position is primarily responsible for drafting and production of drawings for FRP strengthening and conventional structural design based on engineering design. This position will report to the Engineering Manager.

Essential Functions

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Prepare drawings as required by the management
- Transform initial, conceptual structural designs into working documents using computer aided design (CAD)
- Reviews engineering drawings and designs to ensure adherence to established specifications and standards
- Collaborates with design originators to resolve discrepancies between original drawings and final CAD designs
- Effectively reflect design information in the drawings

Supervisory Responsibility

This position does not require any supervisory responsibilities.

Work Environment

This job operates in a professional office environment. This role routinely uses standard office equipment such as computers, phones, photocopiers, scanners, filing cabinets and fax machines. The performance of this position may occasionally require exposure to the R&D laboratory, which may require the use of personal protective equipment such as mandatory safety glasses with side shields and hearing protection.
