



## **Manufacturing Technician**

### **Summary/Objective**

QuakeWrap is an environment where creativity, based on sound structural engineering principles, is required. We design fiber reinforced polymer (FRP) material to strengthen reinforced concrete, steel, masonry and timber structures including buildings, bridges, piers, piles, retaining walls, pipes, penstocks, culverts and tunnels. You will be participating in the manufacturing of many QuakeWrap, Inc. products and innovations. This position will report to the Manufacturing Manager.

### **Essential Functions**

During the manufacturing of composite systems, the employee will need to wear a respirator for extended periods of time. A respiratory fit test will be administered to check fitness level and ensure proper fitting of respirator. Candidates may need to be able lift and hold product and equipment weighing up to 50 pounds, as well as comfortably work while standing for long periods of time.
